<b>EMERGENCY :</b>	<b>9-1-1 (call to be made by Ski Patrol)</b>
<b>First responders:</b>	2 ski patrols at the top of the race hill with: - Sled (including sides and covers)
<b>Ski Patrol HQ at the summit ≤1min from the top of the race</b>	1 ski patrol on stand-by for the duration of the race with: - Backboard - Shell mattress - Cervical collar
<b>Advance life support station (ALS)</b>	1 DEA at the summit patrol HQ 1 Oxygen kit at the summit patrol HQ
<b>Hospital:</b>	Trauma / injuries: St-Jerome Hospital (79 km / 60 minutes) 450-432-2777 Minor injuries: Ste-Agathe Hospital (33 km / 30 minutes) 819-324-4000
<b>Ambulance:</b>	Ambulance Radisson - St-Jovite (10 km / 10 minutes)
<b>Physicians on site:</b>	Available either on site or on call via Clinic at base of mountain (X-rays)
<b>Ski Patrol Contact:</b>	T:819-681-5911 <u>To report accidents</u> // T:819-681-5509 other communications
<b>Communications:</b>	<b>ACA Racer Down protocol will be strictly enforced</b> Patrol Hut has radio contact with Ski Patrol Start referee has verbal contact with first responders at the top of the race hill Kelsey Mullins on hill has contact with jury channel, piste channel and has direct communication with Patrol Hut at the summit
